

## MULTILINGUAL CITY BREAK

Kaziukas Fair is a large annual Lithuanian folk arts and crafts fair dating to the beginning of the 17th century. It was originally held at the two main markets in Vilnius, Lithuania, as well as in the city streets. The fair is traditionally held on the Sunday nearest to St. Casimir's Day. Today, Kaziukas fair also features music and dance; it attracts tens of thousands of visitors and many craftsmen from all over the country as well as from neighboring states such as Latvia, Russia, and Poland. The pavilions of the fair occupy streets and squares in the Old Town of Vilnius.

### DAY 1, FRIDAY

Arrival in Vilnius, optional transfer to Hotel Europa Royale Vilnius\*\*\*\*, check-in; welcome meeting, optional welcome dinner at hotel.

### DAY 2, SATURDAY

Vilnius is known for its more than 1.200 medieval buildings and 48 churches. The morning sightseeing tour includes a panoramic tour of the city and a walking tour of the Old Town with Vilnius Cathedral, Gediminas Tower, Peter and Paul Church, St. Anne's Church, Old University and the Gates of Dawn, the tour ends at the Cathedral square. In the afternoon is offered an optional visit to the Palace of the Grand Dukes of Lithuania – take a tour through the reconstructed palace, where you will learn the historical functions of the residence and will be introduced to permanent exhibitions, related to historical and archaeological development of the palace and restored historical representative interiors. At the end of the tour you will climb to the tower, from which one can admire panorama of Vilnius city.

### DAY 3, SUNDAY

Sunday is reserved for a guided visit of Kaziukas Fair, where you will be introduced to different arts and crafts typical for Lithuania. The arts and crafts at the fair include hand-made goods from local craftsmen, such as apparel, knitted clothes, footwear, toys, utensils, metal crafting, souvenirs, and paintings. Foodstuffs such as rye bread, bagels, honey cookies, meat and dairy products, natural honey, beer, and kvass are sold as well. Traditional "palm" bouquets (called "verbos", hence Verbu sekmadienis) are one of the fair's specialties. In the afternoon we offer optional visit to Amber Museum Gallery in the Old Town to see the amber road, which is presented in an original and artistic way: drops of amber rolling down the pine, expositions of Lithuanian and foreign artists' works and take advantage of experiencing the amber by touching it, smelling and even tasting in a special amber drink. In the evening optional local beer and snacks tasting at beer house Bambalyne. In the evening an optional farewell dinner at the traditional Restaurant Mykolo 4 is on offer.

### DAY 4, MONDAY

Optional transfer to airport.
